Job Posting: Training Division Instructor / Choral Director (Part Time) November 6, 2024

Cantabile Youth Singers of Silicon Valley is looking for an enthusiastic and skilled music teacher for our training choirs (singers aged 6-12), for a five-month contract from January 6 to May 17, 2025, with the opportunity to extend into the following year and grow into a full-time position.

The Training Division Instructor is responsible for teaching weekly classes and conducting performances for our training division choirs (Prelude I, Prelude II, Allegro, & Intermezzo) with singers ages 6-12. All rehearsals take place in Los Altos, CA. The Cantabile curriculum for the Training Division is based in singing, movement, musical games, and mindfulness. Dalcroze, Orff and Kodály methods and practices are all incorporated into the curriculum. The Training Division Instructor will report to the Artistic Director.

Responsibilities:

- Direct 2-4 weekly classes/rehearsals on Tuesday and/or Thursday afternoon/evening each week starting January through May
- Prep for rehearsals, including creating lesson plans and selecting music in collaboration with the Artistic Director as needed
- Deliver musicianship curriculum during these classes
- Communicate with parents and provide semester- or year-end evaluations
- The position includes up to two additional weekend rehearsals per semester, one dress rehearsal each semester and three concerts (December and May), as well as semesterend recitals for the youngest groups (December and April)

Support:

- On-site student assistant to demonstrate, assist with musicianship curriculum and/or provide piano support
- Staff accompanist for pre-concert rehearsals
- Full-time administrative and executive staff manage high-level program oversight and marketing/communications

Qualifications:

- Vocal Music Education degree or equivalent
- Experience in teaching young singers
- Formal training in Orff and Kodály methods, familiarity with Dalcroze method
- Excellent communication and organizational skills
- Functional piano skills
- Reliable transportation to the south Peninsula (rehearsals are in Los Altos, spring concerts will be in Los Altos and Palo Alto)

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Compensation:

This is an independent contractor position. Position will spend an average of six hours per week on-site in rehearsals and performances, with remaining work (prep, communications) done off-site

Compensation range is \$2,200 to \$2,600 per month, commensurate with experience. Payment will be issued monthly upon receipt of invoices.
